



GAMES RULES

Attempts to circumvent these Games Rules will be treated as violations to the regulations and will be punished accordingly. The entire regulation also applies to players who wish to cancel your account or that are being deleted.

1. Each player can use a single account.
2. The account owner is the owner of the email address associated with it.
3. It is not allowed two or more players using the same connection even if with different computers: this will be considered as multiplayer and punishable by temporary or permanent suspension of the account. Players who need to use the same connection must communicate user names and reason at support@medievalife.com with the subject "Multiplayer". It is understood that the authorization to use the same connection is at the discretion of the creator of the game or his assistants. If multiplayer is accepted, players will not have to interact each other in game or help each other in any way.
4. Communicate your password to third parties is a violation of the Rules and will be punished with temporary or permanent suspension of your account.
5. It is forbidden to sell items, services or account or giving free accounts associated with any auction or similar. Punished by immediate delete of your account.
6. Insult, slander, bribery and other questionable statements of any kind will not be tolerated and will be punished to by Administrators.
7. Any type of communication in the game must be made in the language accepted by the recipient.
8. It's prohibited advertising, spam, chain letters, etc.
9. It's forbidden to publish or e-mail messages to or from other game players and administrators, except for reports of misconduct to the Administrators.
10. Force or induce another player to share his/her account, notify your password or violate the regulation is prohibited.
11. Exploiting errors in the game is prohibited and will be punished. The same applies to the use of scripts, bots or similar. The game can only be played using a regular browser.
12. Imitating MedievalLife official institutions, using names and images immoral or politically incorrect is prohibited and is punishable by immediate termination.
13. In case of breach of the Rules, the Administrators will decide the punishment. Players can not request a refund of some or all of the donation made to have the title Sir or Lord, or the Support.
14. The Creator of the Game is the only point of contact for Games Rules violations. Players can discuss with the Creator in the game using messages addressed to Huma Dragonbane or by email at support@medievalife.com and solve the problem.
15. MedievalLife's Staff reserves the right to modify these rules at any time.
16. Individual paragraphs of this regulation should not be effective, this does not affect the validity of the remainder of the regulation. The Administrators undertake to replace the actual rules as fast as possible. The drafts of any new regulations, however, are applicable to all accounts, even if already under ban, although a final version has not yet been published.
17. Donations account for Sir and Lord and Support are to be considered voluntary and players can not request a total or partial refund in case of temporary or permanent suspension of the account due to a violation of rules or technical problems of the game itself.
